1. Preamble

1.1 It is the policy of the KidsAbility School Authority (Board), as required by Statutes of Ontario 2005, Chapter 7 (Sabrina's Law), to ensure the implementation of:

1.1.1 Strategies that reduce the risk of exposure to anaphylactic causative agents in classrooms and common school areas,

1.1.2 A communication plan for the dissemination of information on life-threatening allergies to parents, pupils and employees,

1.1.3 Regular training on dealing with life-threatening allergies for all employees and others who are in direct contact with pupils on a regular basis.

1.2 In addition, the KASA will require that:

1.2.1 The school develop an individual plan for each pupil who has an anaphylactic allergy,

1.2.2 The school principal ensure that, upon registration, parents, guardians and pupils shall be asked to supply information on life-threatening allergies,

1.2.3 The school principal maintain a file for each anaphylactic pupil of current treatment and other information, including a copy of any prescriptions and instructions from the pupil's physician or nurse and a current emergency contact list.
