



## Authority Policy 4010

### ALCOHOL

#### 1. Objective:

1.1 To prohibit the serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages while on KidsAbility School Authority premises.

1.2 To provide guidelines and expectations regarding serving and consumption of alcohol at official KidsAbility School Authority Board sponsored events.

#### 2. Policy

2.1 The KidsAbility School Authority supports the Ministry of Education Provincial Code of Conduct by directing that all members of the school community must not be under the influence of, or provide others, with alcohol on KidsAbility School Authority premises.

2.2 The KidsAbility School Authority considers extra-curricular activities and field trips to be a positive extension of the educational process. Staff and volunteers shall not consume, or be in the possession of, alcohol on a KidsAbility School Authority authorized excursion.

2.3 In the interest of protecting School Authority assets, liability and student wellbeing, the KidsAbility School Authority prohibits the serving, distribution, consumption or possession of alcohol on any KidsAbility School Authority premises.

2.4 This policy applies to all events such as, but not limited to, socials, anniversaries or celebrations held on KidsAbility School Authority premises.

2.5 In the event that a KidsAbility School Authority Board sponsored event is held offsite in a private facility, serving of alcohol is permitted, providing the server has a

Ontario Smart Serve designation.

2.6 This policy supersedes any other policy or procedure with respect to alcohol licensing or the serving of alcohol on KidsAbility School Authority premises.

2.7 This policy recognizes and is sensitive to the legal rights of all students, employees and the Board of KidsAbility School Authority.
