The Youth Work Experience Program is specifically designed to help young people 15-29 years old who are not enrolled in an educational school program and are unemployed or under-employed. Ray of Hope's Youth Employment Training Program, in partnership with Service Canada, has the goal to help these young people receive the employment training, life skills development, and work experience needed for them to make a successful transition to the workforce. This work experience program is 26 weeks (6 months) in length. Each youth who participates will work a total of 35 hours per week and will receive the current provincial minimum wage, plus a \$500 bonus when they successfully graduate.
